- Develops and modifies instructional programs to meet individual needs
- Implements and follows district adopted curricula
- Plans, develops and implements courses of instruction designed to achieve district student learning objectives and grade level expectations
- Develops positive techniques for improving student behavior and manages classroom so as to provide a productive learning environment
- Provides assistance and guidance to individual students through differentiation.
- Reports regularly to parents and is responsive to parental concerns
- Maintains student records including daily grades, attendance reports and others as required
- Uses formative assessment to guide teaching.
- Enforces school rules and monitors student behavior in non-classroom settings
- Incorporates the teaching of writing and higher level thinking skills into the instructional program
- Participates in staff and department meetings
- Works cooperatively with other staff and administrators
- Writes and follows learning targets on a daily basis.

Typical Qualifications
