

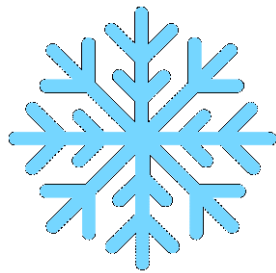
Queets Clearwater School January, 2020 Newsletter
